



## COMPETITOR AND MECHANIC REGULATIONS

### §1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Each member of the Team, Driver, Mechanic must meet the following conditions:
  - a. must be at least 18 years old, individuals who are 16 years old and possess a racing license from the FIA are allowed to participate,
  - b. must have valid health insurance,
  - c. must meet the conditions specified in the Driver and Mechanic Regulations (appendix no. 2),
  - d. must submit the required documents to the Race Office before each Round:
    - i. Declaration (appendix no. 4),
    - ii. Consent to data processing (appendix no. 5).
2. Each Driver must have their own valid Category B Driver's License or possess a racing license from the FIA.
3. All Team members are required to wear closed footwear on the race track. Any flip-flops or sandals are not permitted.
4. After the administrative briefing at the Race Office, the Driver and Mechanic receive an armband with their unique start number on their left arm, which they are obliged to wear throughout their stay on the race track. A Team whose Driver or Mechanic is observed on the race track without the armband will be disqualified.

## §2. COMPULSORY EQUIPMENT FOR DRIVERS

1. Every Driver participating in The Race must wear:
  - a. helmet,
  - b. racing suit,
  - c. racing shoes,
  - d. racing gloves.
2. Only homologated helmets used in car motorsport are permitted in The Race.
3. Each Driver is required to use a karting-type collar, Hans, or hybrid collar. Karting collars will be prohibited from the 2025 season onwards.
4. In 2024, the Organizer recommends the use of fire-resistant underwear. From the 2025 season onwards, racing underwear will be mandatory.
5. The entire attire of the Driver must be homologated. **The homologation may be current or expired.**
6. Failure to meet any of the above criteria will result in the Driver being disqualified from participating in the Round.
7. Introducing changes during a Round that are not compliant with this Regulation will result in the withdrawal of permission to participate in the Round.

## §3. COMPULSORY EQUIPMENT FOR MECHANICS

1. Every Mechanic must wear workwear covering their legs and torso.
2. One-piece overalls or work dungarees are permitted.
3. Protective gloves are required when working on the car.
